I hereby declare that:

ReadSpeaker webReader 3.6, which was released on May 19, 2022, officially passed the WCAG 2.1 AA compliance test conducted by the renowned [accessibility group ONCE](#). The accessibility certification report of June 9, 2022 can be found [here](#). ReadSpeaker webReader speech enables the text content of websites so that visitors can listen to the text.

ReadSpeaker webReader 3.6 was found to have a high degree compliance with the Level A and Level AA success criteria of the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 specification. In fact, the webReader Listen button, player, menu, and pop-up control panel and all functions satisfy all Level A and Level AA success criteria and are all fully keyboard accessible, except for the optional functionalities Text Mode and Page Mask which do not fully satisfy Criterion 2.1.1.

ReadSpeaker has undertaken an Accessibility Audit on ReadSpeaker webReader version 3.7, which was released on November 28, 2022 and I declare that the above applies equally to ReadSpeaker webReader 3.7.
